

REM- Losing My Religion

Just a final break to reflect before continuing the 3x3 & 5D modeling for the 1514-2014 theme. Religion is now a fully valid aspect in the 3x3 ego-state model with 'Belief' as a substitute for S-E. The reason is that Jung's theories include 'religious psychology'. It is quite (psycho-) logical, since 'psyche' mean 'soul' and therefore relates to a wide range of theologies, myths and believes. However, 3x3 Belief also includes any belief-system, like theories of anthropology and any science. Therefore, REM 'Losing my religion' is in this sense related to any belief-system, - political as well.

Religion is also called 'the first philosophy'. It concerns any major unanswered question and not merely the theological ones. (UU 2013.des.27.) Therefore, the 3x3 model's ego-state 'Belief' is a general substitute for Freud's Superior-Ego. This means that laws, ethics and rituals are included. Moreover, the 3x3 model adds the 3 levels; UnderConscience, Conscience and OverConscience (U, C and O) to the 3 classic ego-states Id/Drive, Ego/Will and Superior-Ego/Belief (D, W and B). Temporary key-words for the ego-state Belief are: UB; Intuition, obsessions, rituals, psychosis. CB; Philosophy, religion, politics, ethics. OB; [S-E] Traditions, rituals, superstitions, hypnosis". The models are described in English in UU 2014.sept.12.

In this sense, Belief relates to all of the ego-states Id/Child, Ego/Adult and S-E/Parent, - since there can be uncertainties and beliefs about logical and natural concerns too. In a TA (Transaction Analysis) viewpoint, communications can stem from a person's CB expressed via OB and received by another person's OD to possibly be adapted by the CD and even UD. Believes, which are not quite qualified explanations, are used as temporary solutions for uncertainties. Therefore, it is important for anyone to realize that their belief is not knowledge. Besides, our dogmatic or faulty beliefs should be open for corrections, innovations and even invalidations.

No-one can possibly understand it all, not anything close, not even those who claims to be related to some divinity, ideal or genius. No prophet have ever proved to be any superior Truthsayer. For example, the Oracle of Delphi, with all the unclear answers, became politically corrupt and disastrous damaging. This goes as well for any theology, ideology and anthropology. Fixed minds on Superior-Ego Believes can develop personal and organizational psychoses. The only cure is to realize and accept that any belief has a high level of uncertainty and therefor often have faults. Consequently, willingness to change one's own Belief should be a pre-condition to enter any belief-system of theology, ideology and anthropology.

Political Beliefs, like ideologies, are talked over in UU 2013.nov.29: "Isms are used to explain ideas, politics and theologies. They are used to influence attitudes and actions. They are made, social-psychologically said, as S-E to establish collective norms and ideals. However, there are now myriads of isms that provide overwhelming inconsistency and confusion. Furthermore, they are more influenced by abstract philosophies than concrete solutions." In UU 2013.april.19 the suffix '-cracy' (power) is reasoned in relation to LifeQuality and social-psychological Games. "There are several well-known terms like theocracy, bureaucracy and democracy. Put together with known prefixes, some new terms of powers reveal, like psychocracy, sociocracy and pedocracy." "Anyways, the mentioned Games relates more concrete to cracies than isms. One can therefore speculate if there isn't some hidden Games behind any political idea or ism, - that their objectives isn't always like presented."

Religious believes are talked over in UU 2013mars29 and UU 30.Mars.2012: "Since more than half the human population acknowledge the monotheistic religions, they consequently believe in life after death, souls, angels and spirits." "Historically, there have been always rivalries in the Mediterranean areas, - in the

intersection between the 3 empires in the Middle-east, North-Africa and South-Europe. These 3 were irreconcilable in language, culture, ethnicity and religions." The rivalry seems eternal and they still highly influence most present major collective Beliefs. Religious Beliefs in E.T. is also argued. "The monotheistic belief is that God created (at least) 3 intelligent life forms; Humans, Angels and Djinnns. The latter is also called spirits or demons, which is a life form without a body, - a form of energy. Therefore philosophies about possibly human life after the death (of the body), is as a soul or spirit." Furthermore, religious philosophies includes intermating between the species, which makes that psychology highly complex and controversial.

Our archetypes are internal and stems from UD (UnderConscience Drive). These have every so often been mistaken for divinities that should however be external and come via OB (OverConscience Beliefs). Nevertheless, the term 'anthropology' is highly relevant to the ego-state Drive (Id). Anthropology is defined as; "the study of humans', past and present, that draws and builds upon knowledge from the social sciences and biological sciences, as well as the humanities and the natural sciences." The definition and models for LifeQuality are therefor also essentials to anthropologies. (See UU 2014.sept.05.) The term 'ethnology' originally means 'nation' and is a relevant branch because it concerns the characteristics of different peoples and the relationship between them. Ethnology is therefore most relevant to organizational, national and imperial social-psychology.

CdE Games will be in focus in the continuation of the UU theme '1514-2014'. Consequently, collective Belief-Shifts are too. There have been several 4th degree CdE Games throughout history like in Rome, Egypt, Beijing, Washington, Paris, Vienna and Iran. However, most profound and documented is the Russian CdE Games throughout the 20th century, - from Throne/Temple in the Winter Palace to State in Moscow. There was a massive organized collective Belief-Shift from ethnological/theological to ideological. The methods included persuasion, bribery, threats, torture, hypnosis, assimilation, massacres and wars. Somehow the conquering regime believed that all humanity would submit to their ideals. They really believed they could cause a chain-reaction of global neo-dogmatic Belief-Shift in every national states, - by temporary abuse of anti-civilized means. How desperate, how ignorant and how psychotic to believe that human nature is that simple, - and that similar to animals and machines? A main concern of this century has to be to terminate the sociopathic devastation, stop the vast corruption and restore the civilizations and its citizens LQ. Challenging indeed, when they still have an OverConscience that destruction is for some greater good. Anyways, 5D scenarios based on LQ and 3x3 models will be in focus for 2014-2114.

The name of the band 'REM' is short for 'Rapid Eye Movements'. It is a natural reaction of the eyes when 'falling asleep'. It is intriguing to know that we spend 1/3 of our lives at sleep and that we don't remember much from that UD 'ego-state'. However, sleep is vital for our LQ. Being tired, and lacking a good night's sleep can ruin the day for CW. Even worse, sleeplessness can cause insanity, or at least similar interpretations of such a semi-UD state. Unfortunately sleeplessness is used as an effective form of torture to break individuals' Ego/Will. Anyways, dreams are important to Jung's theories because it gets access to the Under-conscience and can provide information about the psyche. However, interpretation of dreams are less emphasized in this century.

The lyrics in 'Losing My Religion' is about confusion and despair. It is more about loss of Belief than any 'first philosophy'. "Life is bigger than you and you are not me." It's about doubt in social psychoses and potential new realizations. "I've said too much - haven't said enough, I've said enough". It is also about negative social reactions to the alienation. "That's me in the corner, in the spotlight, losing my religion." Trying to live up to unreachable ideal Beliefs can cause feelings of inadequacy and thereby inferiority: "Trying to keep an eye on you, like a hurt, lost and blinded fool." Hopeless interpretations intensify the confusion: "I thought I heard you laughing, I thought I heard you sing, I think I thought I saw you try." However, as a true REM, he sings "That was just a dream".

The video tells as much as the lyrics. His body-language is restless and confused. There are scenes with philosophical and religious motives. A fallen angel appears like a weakened human, mocked and martyred. Atheists are sceptic but tries to make iron wings. (A somehow related REM presentation appears in UU 02.nov.2012.)
