

Leningrad Cowboys – Leningrad

Roma3 of 2014 is not like the previous, - it seems. It is, however, as challenging as before to diagnose. Such is called Kremlinology and is basically like Vaticanology, where public communication is in the uncommon Latin and by smoke-signals on selection-days. Similarly, Russian and gun-smoke is not the only expressions to analyze. In the next 4 UU, the models of 3x3, 5D, Games, LQ in addition to the documentary 'Putin, Russia and The West', will be used to get some views on what happens and should happen in relations to Norden.

'Putin, Russia and the West' is a four-part BBC documentary from 2012 about the relations between Vladimir Putin's Russia and the West. (West in Russian sense means EU and US that is west of Moscow.) The series won a Peabody Award in 2012 because it; "exposes and explains history as process, as something made with choices rather than something to be recalled and described." However, there are also some negative critics like: "No-one tells anything from Putin's inner circle, the so-called siloviki" (politicians from the security or military services). "(It is) nothing less than a party political broadcast for Putin and his United Russia party." "Putin's anti-democratic crusade largely being a legitimate reaction to the hostile policies of the West, especially the United States". Nevertheless the critics, - the series gives structure and drive for the 3x3, 5D and Game analysis.

This first part is called "Taking Control". A public summary at Wikipedia says: "(The) newly elected President of the United States George W. Bush famously declared in June 2001 that he had looked Putin in the eye and 'got a sense of his soul'. It is revealed that on the same occasion, Putin had given Bush a prophetic warning about Pakistan, Afghanistan and the Taliban." "This episode looks at Putin's relationship with Russia's oligarchs, particularly vis-a-vis Russia's oil supplies, ultimately leading to the arrest."

Here are some personal summaries about the first episode: 'Taking Control', followed by some comments.

- The documentary do not go into the former 10 years and the inevitable contra-revolution to 1914. Mikhail Gorbachov was the last SU leader and ended the Stalin period by initiating Glasnost (openness) and Perestroika (restructuring). The elected president Boris Yeltsin made that happen by liberal democratic laws and forced the previous autocratic regime to leave. However, Yeltsin could not control the cascading effects in society and seemed to lose control.
- Unexpectedly, Yeltsin resigned and pointed at Vladimir Putin as the Acting President. Putin was positioned symbolically on the very first day of the new millennium. Previously, Putin was an officer in the KGB (now FSB). He was a specialist in counter-intelligence for 16 years in East Germany and might therefor be related to STASI. He got into politics in St Petersburg (Leningrad) in 1991 and moved to Moscow to join President Boris Yeltsin's administration in 1996. 4 years later, the secret services ended democracy by use of Putin and regained control of the State.
- The capitalist State needed new capital. In that sense it seemed necessary to confiscate capital from some oligarchs of the 'private sector'. In brief, there is oligarchy when society is dominated by the small minority of the wealthiest citizens, - hereby called oligarchs. A Russian (private) oligarch is almost synonym to non-state businesses. They acquired huge wealth fast from State-capital in Russia and former SU satellite States in the 90'.
- Some oligarchs were invited to business-meetings with Putin. The State oil company Rosneft was minor and inferior at that time. An oligarch claimed that the corruption of State bureaucrats was 10% of GDP. Putin claimed they were just as corrupt, which legitimized investigations. The State took their capital with law regulations, prosecution, exiling and arrests. The State also hindered democracy movements and foreign relations. All in all, the State regained control of vital properties like the law, media, energy,

minerals etc. This conflict between oligarchs and the State is still very tense, - and has probably been so for 100 years since the Game of CdE (Coup d' Etat) from Throne to State in 1914.

- Both the US and SU lost their main enemy when the cold-war ended in 1990. Both had large war-related enterprises for military, weapons, diplomats, agents, spies etc. The US president George W. Bush wanted to expel SU secret agents, but could not due to their new and 'friendly' relations. In fact more secret agents were added since they were uncovered in EU during the 'glasnost' of STASI.
- Both US and SU were designed for global war-fare and needed new focus for that. There was even a question of joint military alliance in NATO, but that was too controversy. They made new strategies and agreed to cooperate when needed. (In this relation, this 'neo-Russia' can be referred to as neo-SU or simply SU.)
- The US & SU found a new shared enemy in the theocratic and oil-dominant Middle East. The failed SU wars towards Muslims in Chechnya/Caucasus and Afghanistan were humiliating and weakening. SU wanted US in a joint warfare. Putin's 'prophetic warning' to Bush was realized with 9/11. Then SU granted immediately access for US on their SU air-bases to bomb Iraq. The captured Islamists were sent to the SU satellite-State Cuba for imprisonment and interrogations.
- The new US-SU agreement didn't last long though. Putin had Germany and France to vote against the Iraq wars in the UN. That made a serious diplomatic division on US-EU, - like in the Game DOC (Divide & Conquer). Anyways, US went to war on terror in the Temple-related Middle East. Consequently the oil price rose and the SU State got rich due to increased oil-taxes and confiscated oil-resources. US, as a major oil consumer, had to pay the increased prices. The state's oil-company Rosnef acquired others' oil fields and got powerful.
- Even though Chechnya was a military failure under Yeltsin and success under Putin, the Muslims were not settled at all. The Chechens/Caucasian took hostages in a Moscow theatre and demanded Putin's resignation. Clearly there is no tolerance for such since the state wiped out all with an unknown poisonous gas, including all hostages. (Curiously, Stalin was a Caucasian too, - and did terrorize Russia in similar ways. However, the State seems to have changed the point of view on such domestic activities now.)

All in all, the first period was a tremendous success for Putin personally and the secret services. They were simply Taking Control, - like in a Game of CdE. Putin got powerful, the State got stable and stronger. On the other hand, - Russia got less democratic. The new Secret Services regime proved that they are anti-glasnost (anti-openness) and pro-perestroika (restructuring). Even KGB was renamed to FSB and closed down the outdated and exposed STASI organization in Eastern Europe. However, it didn't vanish, - it just innovated and moved.

There is no doubt that the neo-SU regime in Roma3 is a hard-core Game player of 4th degree. The simple fact that a secret agent was put in autocratic power says it all. The Secret Services are like the very definition of psycho-social Games (UU 2014.sept.12). A transparent example is that the democratic elected president Yeltsin surrendered himself to the new Secret Service organization. Even though the reason is a secret, it is highly likely that there were accusations related to national security (UU 2014.juni.13).

It would be a grave mistake to over-focus on Putin personally in Game analyzing the organization, the empire, - Roma3. He is probably not in real power, but merely a marionette to publically execute some pre-defined moves. Previous such peer-managers in SU were Stalin, Lenin and even (agent) Rasputin (UU 2014.mai.30).

Identifying and profiling the true nature of the imperial secret organization is like doing Vaticanology and Kremlinology. Previously, it has been identified and described as the Praetor of Roma1, the Praetors (network) of Roma2 and the Oprichnina of Roma3 (UU 2014.mai.02 and UU 2013.Mai.24). Furthermore,

Superior-Ego and Superior-ID (S-E & S-I) were described in UU 2014.jan.10. This theory is merged together in a joint Freudian and Jungian 3x3 egostates model. S-E and S-I are like the OverConscience of Belief and Drive (OB and OD), which means they can both influence collective synchronization, - like some 'peoples' movements'.

There might be positive reasons for the State to take control over the Throne-like oligarches. Using the 3-state value system RCG (Right-Constructive-Good), which is related to 3x3 ego-states (Belief-Will-Drive), seems not to indicate major WDB (Wrong-Destructive-Bad) in the restructuring. It is actually a remarkable achievement. For example, more transparent, today's Roma1 mafia has a budget like the Norwegian GNP. The State and Temple do joint 'war on crime' by prosecutions, exposure and excommunications. Similar organized crimes should be looked into in Europe, Norden and Norway, since Russians are involved here too.

The new US-SU trust was founded on that: 'Bush got a sense of Putin's soul' and that: "a prophetic warning about the Taliban." This has some religious references, - including occult djinns and demons. It might very well be that the religious Bush was deliberately influenced to believe there were divine forces at play. He probably also wanted to finish the Iraq war that was started in his father's period. The secret services accusations that Iraq was responsibility for 9/11 has never been proved and is still highly questionable. This is the major Game-shift of this century where the war in the middle-east were handed over from SU to US.

Concluding the first chapter "Taking Control", - the Secret Services did execute a Game of CdE by getting their agent Putin as Head of State. Strangely enough, viewed through the media, it might look like some well executed project – a kind of 'Project CdE'. It is a reminder of some other critics of the BBC series: "FSB (neo-KGB) used the (Spy-Rock and) BBC film to resurrect old propaganda just when mass demonstrations are going on in Moscow before the presidential election". Secret Services (like UK MI6) can neither confirm nor deny such accusations, which gives the accuser a great advantage. How common such Games seem to be for Roma3 with revolutions, CdE, bully elections, puppet presidents and annexations. That is vital to remember in Norden too.

The band The Leningrad Cowboys was made in a bar in 1986 as a joke on the declining powers of the [Soviet Union](#) (SU). The band is from Finland and frequently perform rock and roll covers. Their trademark is exaggerated pompadour hairstyles and long pointy shoes. To top it all, they also performs with a Russian military band. This song 'Leningrad' is inspired by the Finnish psyche that is influenced by the dark sides of SU after invasions. Billy Joel, being an American, has a more sympatric tale, though. Now, which one suites the youngster Vladimir Putin of Leningrad the most? Maybe a bit of both. Then he was a small boy in the streets of Leningrad with gangsters, seeing how it was and thinking what to do about it.
